




- Screening Process for regular KSB user (EPIC employees and Clients employees)

- 2. For visitors that hold 3-months temporary pass, there are required to declare and undergo temperature screening at KSB entrance. The client company that request for the temporary pass are required to remind this requirement to their visitors.
- 3. Clients company shall have record of their employees who are coming or travel from affected countries within 14-days of arrival to Malaysia. EPIC highly recommended that those employees to be placed under self-quarantine or work at home arrangement before they are allowed to enter Kemaman Supply Base (KSB).


