Valuable Clients & Tenants of EPIC Group,

We regret to inform you that there have been 2 cases of COVID-19 positive cases at Kemaman Supply Base. In the first case, an employee of EPIC Oilfield Services Sdn Bhd (EOS) has tested positive for COVID-19. He was last on the premises of Kemaman Supply Base on 23 May 2021. In the second case, an employee of one of our tenants at Phase 2 in Kemaman Supply Base, Destini Oil Services Sdn Bhd (Destini) has also tested positive for COVID-19. He was last on the premises of Kemaman Supply Base on 25 May 2021. The said employees are currently being quarantined at a government authorised facility. Additionally, another tenant's employee at Phase 2, Setegap Ventures Petroleum Sdn Bhd (Setegap) is a close contact for COVID-19 and is currently under quarantine.

EPIC Berhad, EOS, Destini and Setegap has started our process flow for the management of COVID-19 cases at our premises. As a precaution, a thorough sanitisation and deep cleaning of the affected location has been carried out. The premises will be temporarily closed to facilitate the sanitisation.

We have been in constant contact with the tenants to identify all those in direct contact with the affected employees to undergo swab tests and to be placed under quarantine until given the appropriate medical clearance. Contact tracing with assistance from the Health Ministry of Malaysia to identify all others with direct contact with the employee is also being conducted. To date, a total of 35 employees have been identified and undergoing quarantine (EOS - 7, Destini – 16, Setegap - 12).

EPIC had earlier implemented several precautionary measures to ensure the well-being of clients and tenants, which includes mandatory temperature screening at all entry points, closures of main internal premises like surau, sports and recreational facilities, Work-From-Home programme for non-critical staff, control and restriction of off-premises movement at work and work-break times and activating our 24-hour Emergency Response Centre hotline.

We advise all our clients and tenants to follow strict guidelines set by each respective company and Health Ministry to ensure the safety of everyone working at Kemaman Supply Base.
